What is a Privacy Notice?

UK data protection law Data Protection Act 2018

- To facilitate appropriate communications with pupils and families

academies do not store personal data indefinitely; data is only stored for as long as is necessary to complete the task for which it was originally collected.

Will my information be shared?

The Department for Education (DfE) collects personal data from educational settings and local authorities via various statutory data collections. We are required to share information about our pupils with the Department for Education (DfE) either directly or via our local authority for the purpose of those data collections, under regulation 5 of The Education (Information About Individual Pupils) (England) Regulations 2015.

The National Pupil Database (NPD) is managed by the DfE and contains information about pupils in schools in England. Wickersley Partnership Trust is required by law to provide information about our pupils to the DfE as part of statutory data collections, such as the school Census; some of this information is then stored in the NPD. The DfE may share information about our pupils from the NPD with third parties who promote the education or wellbeing of children in England by:

All data is transferred securely and held by DfE under a combination of software and hardware controls, which meet the current [government security policy framework](#). For more information, please see 'How Government uses your data' section

We may be required to share information about our pupils with the local authority to ensure that they can conduct their statutory duties under the [Schools Admission Code](#), including conducting Fair Access Panels.

Who we routinely share pupil information with:

- Pupils' destinations upon leaving the school
- Local Authorities (Local Councils)
- The NHS including the School Nursing Service, Speech and Language Therapists
- Other agencies i.e. Social Care, Police, Public Health England
- The system we use for managing pupil welfare (CPOMS)
- The systems we use to help manage school finance
- The cashless payments systems available to parents
- Our door entry systems
- The systems and resources we use to help deliver the curriculum including Google Classroom, mcche >> BDC
